

## **Eyepieces and Monitors**

## What needs to be cleaned?

- Eyepieces on microscopes (6 in Plant Lab, 1 in Cloud Forest)
- Eyepieces on refractometers (2 in Plant Lab)
- Eyepieces on kaleidoscopes (6 along handrail in Rain Forest)

## How do we clean them?

- Pick up the small white bucket of eyepiece cleaning supplies at the Information Desk. It should contain: q-tips, a glass cloth, a spray bottle of lens cleaner, a spray bottle of screen cleaner, and the key to the microscope cases.
- 2. Spray lens cleaner onto a clean q-tip. (Don't spray the eyepiece of the equipment directly, since it might flood the lens).
- 3. Wipe the damp q-tip on the eyepiece, cleaning the area around the lens where people's eyes might touch it. The goal is to clean off germs and remove eye makeup.
- 4. To clean monitors, spray screen directly with **screen cleaner**. Use glass cloth to wipe down.
